

VIRGINIA ENDORSEMENT

Successful completion of the courses and a passing score on the SLLA meet eligibility requirements for the Administration and Supervision PreK-12 endorsement.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Official master's degree transcript from a regionally accredited college or university
- Letter of recommendation from your superintendent or principal
- Current, valid Virginia postgraduate teaching license or equivalent from another state
- Minimum of two years teaching experience

TUITION AND FEES

Based on current tuition rates, tuition costs \$285* per credit for Virginia residents and \$355* per credit for non-Virginia residents, plus a one-time application fee. These costs do not include textbooks. The University offers a monthly payment plan option.
