**University Update**

President Reveley provided Board members present with updates on a range of university issues, including: admissions, the golf course, developments related to the use of emotional support animals on campus, and strategic issues related to partners around the Commonwealth. Reflecting on the success of the previous fiscal year, he noted: the award of the Vice Presidential Debate, a record \$42 million from the General Assembly, the hiring of a new Prince Edward County Superintendent, approval of the Master Plan, and an increase in donors and annual giving. The most difficult challenge of the year had been the tragic loss of student Shiv Sharma in an automobile accident. He also shared thoughts on long-term trends in higher education as well as public policy and budgetary issues.

Mrs. Margiloff proposed a motion to go into Closed Session under Section 2.2-3711(A)(1) of the Code of Virginia to discuss matters pertaining to the performance of Longwood University employees. Mrs. Radcliff so moved, Ms. Trigiani seconded and the motion was unanimously approved.

A motion was made by Mrs. Margiloff to return to open session. The motion was seconded by Mr. Wertz and approved unanimously by the Board by roll call vote.

There being no further business, the Executive Committee meeting adjourned at 4:30 p.m.
